## The Unraveling of a Chicago to Rockford Heroin Ring



### **Rockford Man Sentenced to More Than 26 Years in Federal Prison on Federal Drug Conspiracy Charges**

*Steven T. McDowell, 38, of Rockford, also known as "Ty," was sentenced by U.S. District Judge Frederick J. Kapala to 315 months in federal prison for his role in a conspiracy to distribute at least one kilogram of heroin and ordered to serve five years of supervised release following his imprisonment. McDowell was convicted on June 14, 2012, after a nine-day jury trial in U.S. District Court in Rockford, of one count of conspiracy to distribute heroin and six counts of distribution of heroin.*
